Legavallon Rd, approx. 9km to the North East of Dungiven & 8km West of Garvagh.

Proposal:Proposed amendments to the original consent

B/2009/0070/F consisting of: - a reduction in the overall turbine tip height from 120.5m to 114.90m; a reduction in height from 85m to 68.9m and an increase in rotor diameter from 71m to 92m, for all 7 turbines - a new development site entrance; relocation of the combined substation & construction compound area; and a revised access track route to service T1, T2, T5 & T6 (as per previous consent B/2013/0196/f) - all ancillary development including minor increases in the size of the

crane pads & wind turbine foundations to accommodate

the newly proposed turbine models - The installed capacity will be 16.45MW.
