1.0 Background

The 'Protocol for the Operation of the Planning Committee' sets out the requirement to provide monthly updates on the number of planning applications received and decided.

2.0 Details

- 2.1 Website link 1 and Website Link 2 provide a list of planning applications received and decided respectively by Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council in the month of October 2018. Please note that Pre-Application Discussions; Certificates of Lawful Development Proposed or Existing; Discharge of Conditions and Non-Material Changes, have to be excluded from the reports to correspond with official validated statistics published by DFI.
- 2.2 Table 1 below details the number of Major planning applications received and decided as well as the average processing times. Please note that these figures are unvalidated statistics. In comparison to the same period last year, the number of major applications received has remained the same as the same period last year however the number of major applications decided has increased by 4.

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2.3 Table 2 below details the number of Local planning applications received and decided as well as the average processing times. Please note these figures are unvalidated statistics. In comparison to the same period last year, the number of decisions issued has increased by 121 applications (14% increase) and more decisions have been issued than applications received.

In comparison to the same period last year, the number of cases brought to conclusion has increased by 21 and the percentage of cases concluded within the 39 weeks increasing to 77.6% ytd.

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2.6 Resources continue to be targeted to reduce the over 12 month applications.
