Summary

The Department of Justice is working with the Home Office to commence the remainder of the Criminal Finances Act 2017 (CFA 2017) in Northern Ireland in 2021. Before the commencement of the relevant provisions, the following nine Codes of Practice issued under POCA need to be revised to reflect some of the provisions introduced under the CFA 2017:

- Two Search, Seizure and Detention of Property Codes of Practice issued under s.195S and s.195T of POCA;
- Two Recovery of Cash: Search Powers Codes of Practice issued under s.292 and s.293A of POCA;
- Three Investigations Codes of Practice issued under section 377, s.377A and s.377ZA of POCA; and
- Two Recovery of Listed Assets: Search Powers Codes of Practice issued under s.303G and s.303I of POCA.

The POCA Codes of Practice provide operational guidance on the exercise of the relevant powers. The consultations are open to all. Responses are particularly welcome from agencies or individuals (law enforcement officers, accredited financial investigators or prosecutors) accredited with the relevant powers under POCA.

The Department of Justice consultation

The Department of Justice is consulting on the s.195T, the s.293A, the s.377ZA and the s.303I codes. The codes provide guidance on the exercise of the relevant powers in Northern Ireland by constables and accredited financial investigators.
