1.0 Background

1.1 BT consulted the Council on 5th February 2021 on the removal of the public payphone service at the junction of Cozies Road/Castlecat Road (see photos on page 2) and to allow the Ballylough Living History Trust to adopt the K6 red telephone box for the local community (see Appendix 1).

2.0 Detail

- 2.1 BT have advised that it has received a request from June Traill, CEO, Ballylough Living History Trust, to adopt the K6 telephone kiosk 02820741374.
- 2.2 BT have advised that they are meeting their obligation to provide a Universal Service as there are other kiosks remaining in the area. The nearest alternative kiosk is at Orby Drive, Luscolman. Ballymoney, BT53 8EB, which is 2951 meters away.
- 2.3 BT have an obligation to consult with the relevant public bodies on the proposed removal and require a response within 90 days.

REMOVAL OF PUBLIC PAYPHONE SERVICE:

I am writing to advise you that BT has received a request from June Traill, CEO, Ballylough Living History Trust, to adopt the K6 telephone kiosk 02820741374 Cosies Road Junction Castlecat Road Castlecatt BT53 8AP.

Our obligation to provide a Universal Service will be maintained, as there are other kiosks within the vicinity. The nearest alternative kiosk is at Orby Drive, Luscolman. Ballymoney. BT53 8EB, which is 2951 meters away.

Before we can remove a kiosk we have an obligation to consult with relevant public bodies on the proposed removal. As part of the consultation process it is a requirement that the Council reply in writing to BT within 90-days giving their comments or any objections received from the local community.

I am writing on behalf of the CEO, Mrs Traill, and ask that Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council do not raise any objection to cease of service so the Trust can adopt the telephone kiosk, which is their desire.
