1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek approval from Elected Members for the re-opening of the Town Halls.

2.0 Background

2.1 As part of the Covid-19 restrictions agreed by Council in March 2020, the Town Halls were closed and staff then re-located to other Civic Buildings to assist with cleaning regimes.

3.0 Proposal

3.1 It is proposed to re-open Kilrea, Portrush, Coleraine and Ballymoney Town Halls from 1st July 2021.

3.2 Each of the Town Halls has been risk assessed and control measures identified in line with the Covid-19 guidelines. Unfortunately this may restrict some of the activities and bookings that would normally take place. Bookings will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

4.0 Recommendation

It is recommended that the Corporate Policy and Resources Committee approve the re-opening of Kilrea, Portrush, Coleraine and Ballymoney Town Halls from 1st July 2021.
