## 1.0 PPC Permit

## **GRANT OF PPC PERMIT**

**Premises:** Spar Mountsandel, Sandel Local Centre, Knocklynn Road,

Coleraine

**Application:** An application has been received for a vapour recovery

permit to operate an installation unloading petrol into stationary storage tanks (Stage 1) and motor vehicle refuelling activities (Stage 2), at the above service station.

The above service station has provided evidence to Council, confirming that the total quantity of petrol unloaded into the storage tanks is greater than 500m³, in any 12 month period. In addition, the premises have recently undergone a major refurbishment. This means that a stage 1 & 2 PPC permit is required

An inspection has been carried out and the premises complies with the vapour recovery measures required for a PPC Permit.

The permit has been granted under delegated authority.
