The Consultation relates to proposals for Regulations (secondary legislation) that DE has to have in place by 11 May 2023, under the Period Products (Free Provision) Act (Northern Ireland) 2022.

DE is not consulting on whether or not free period products should be widely available to the public - that is already provided for under the Act. The Regulations will be the first step in putting the law into place in DE's areas of responsibility, including schools, Education Other Than At School (EOTAS) settings, pupil referral units, statutory youth settings and office accommodation of specified 'Public Service Bodies'.
