2. Air Display Update (Roger Steele):

Event dates 10 & 11 September 2022.

 - Sunday Irish Air Corp (Sunday)

3. Industry and MoD Update (Kim Spragg):

STEM

- 33 confirmed exhibitors with some new exhibitors attending (significant increase from 2019 with 21 exhibitors).
- The STEM flyer has been produced and has been distributed

- Website has STEM section to encourage exhibitors.
- Quiet hour will be included in STEM village on both days.

Industry / MoD Liaison

Friday industry half-day:

- ADS Led and Industry funded.
- Bushmills Distillery tour and tasting arranged sponsored by an aerospace company.
- Evening reception booked at Magherabouy Hotel, hosted by RAF.
- Chief Executive of Farnborough International Airshow will be in attendance.

Corporate and Spectator Hospitality

- 3 Key Speakers agreed Spirit Aero systems, National Cyber Security Centre and RAF.
- Farnborough International Airshow links established and a representative will be in attendance at the Saturday Business Engagement Day.
- It is hoped that a representative from Farnborough International News Network will be in attendance.
- Saturday and Sunday invites for Corporate Hospitality have been issued from Mayors Office. With a response of 29th July stated, once numbers confirmed then ticket sales will be made for remaining places.
- It is anticipated that all 150 places will be filled for both days.

Ground Layout / Logistics

<u>The University</u> Coleraine – Assessing the possibility of securing the University for Limavady traffic.
