	<p>Economy Minister Gordon Lyons has launched a public consultation on the development of an Energy “One-Stop Shop” (OSS). The One Stop Shop will work with partners to consolidate advice, guidance and support in energy-related matters in an effort to simplify the energy decarbonisation journey for consumers, whether they need impartial advice on what to do and how to do it, or protection along the decarbonisation journey.</p> <p>This will be a vitally important pillar on the journey to energy decarbonisation and will provide a gateway for consumers seeking information, advice and guidance on energy-related matters.
