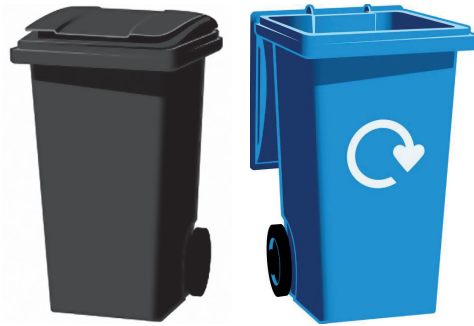

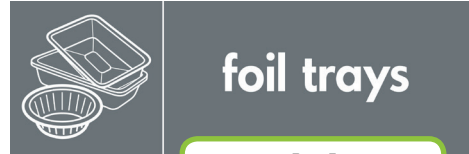

Do not put any of the following items in your blue bin

- X** Pyrex, crystal or window glass
- X** Shredded paper
- X** Nappies
- X** Tissues
- X** Plastic trays used for raw meat
- X** Electrical equipment
- X** General rubbish
- X** Food waste
- X** Plastic bags
- X** Polystyrene
- X** Wrapping paper / wallpaper
- X** Plastic bags, crisps, sweets, biscuit wrappers
- X** Take-away pizza boxes
- X** Plastic packaging
- X** Blister packs

Tips for using your recycling bin

- Do not bag any of the materials you put in your bin
- Please ensure all items for recycling are washed and don't contain any food or drink residue
- Remove any plastic packaging around catalogues and magazines
- If the wrong materials are put in your bin we will not empty it until you remove the incorrect items; it will then be emptied on your next collection
