Location Lands opposite entrance to 59 Magheramore Rd, Dungiven, BT47 4SW in the townlands of Carnanbane and Maghermore, Approx 4km south of Dungiven.

Proposal: (Amended description) Construction of a Wind Farm (with a generating capacity of between 21.6MW & 24 MW) comprising up to 6 no Wind Turbine (Max of 149.9m to blade tip with a max rotor diameter of 112m & max hub height of 94m) & associated infrastructure including external electricity transformers, crane hardstandings, underground cabling, control building, substation compound, energy storage area, (up to 5 MW hours), newly created site entrance (Opp 59 Magermore Road), New and upgraded on-site access tracks, turning heads & all other associated ancillary works. During construction & commissioning there will be a number of temporary works including enabling works compound & construction compound with car parking, temporary parts of crane hardstanding, welfare facilities & off-site road
