NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

The following supporting documents are required;

- ➤ Site layout plan (mandatory) This plan should show the boundaries of the site, the positions of caravan standings and the following particulars:
 - Water supply*
 - Communal toilet and shower facilities*
 - Communal laundry and washing up facilities*
 - Sewage disposal*
 - Waste water disposal*
 - Refuse storage and disposal*
 - Site lighting*
 - Fire precautions*
 - Surface water drainage
 - Recreation space
 - Vehicle parking spaces
 - Planting of trees and bushes for amenity purposes
 - Carriageways and footpaths

*Indicates mandatory information required

- Planning permission (mandatory).
 - Evidence that there is a planning order in force for permission to use the land as a caravan site.
- ➤ Electrical Test Certificate (mandatory) for the electrical installation up to point of supply to individual caravans.
- Fire Fighting Equipment (mandatory)
 - Test/ supply certificates for firefighting equipment placed on site.
- Emergency Lighting Test Certificates (mandatory)
 - Test certificate for testing emergency lighting on site if supplied
- Fire Alarm System Test Certificate (mandatory)
 - If supplied on site any electrical fire alarm system should be tested periodically.

Details should also be provided for the arrangements for refuse and litter collection and disposal.

A fee of £10 must also accompany this application.
