











The Northern Ireland Rural Development Programme (NIRDP) 2014-2020 is part funded by the Department of Agriculture Environment & Rural Affairs (DAERA) and the European Union (EU).

The NIRDP 2014-2020 is delivered by Causeway Coast & Glens Council Local Action Group (LAG) which is made up of local councillors and social partners representing the rural community in the Borough.

The total amount of funding available under the Programme is £7.83M and this has been invested by the LAG into local businesses, community organisations, villages and tourism projects.

The Programme has offered funding to:

- 88 Businesses Investment £3.3M
- 20 Community organisation projects Investment £2.6M
- 21 Village projects Investment £966K
- 5 Tourism projects Investment £964K

The successful delivery of the Programme has helped rural business to create 152 new full-time jobs and 14 new part time jobs in addition to providing improved accessibility to local services for rural dwellers and the regeneration of villages.

Improvements have been made to the local tourism product on offer outside of the high-profile tourist attractions in the Borough and these improvements have contributed to increased footfall and an economic boost to local rural businesses. The Programme has been an tremendous success and has enhanced the lives and future prospects of many of our rural residents.



As current Chair of the Causeway Coast & Glens Local Action Group (LAG), I am delighted to endorse this brochure which encapsulates the success of the Northern Ireland Rural Development Programme.

I pay tribute to the local rural business community, voluntary organisations and village groups who made this Programme a success by taking risks at a time of great uncertainty for us all. Without their contribution and co-operation this Programme would not have realised its full potential.

# Village Renewal Scheme

The Village Renewal Scheme funded Village Plans for 25 villages in the Borough to be created or updated to give a current position on the key priority actions that would improve village life for residents.

21 of these villages were successful in availing of funding to address priority items attracting a total investment from the Programme of £966,129. This was matched by Causeway Coast & Glens Council funding amounting to £316,715.

A wide and varied number of projects were delivered ranging from installation of new Multi-Use Games Areas (MUGA) and Playparks to improved signage, way-markers and walking paths all of which were delivered with the approval of and in partnership with the villages groups concerned.

These interventions have helped to regenerate the villages and bring a welcome boost to village life in the current difficult circumstances.










































## Transnational Co-Operation Scheme

The Transnational Co-Operation Scheme successfully delivered 5 projects in the Causeway Coast & Glens Borough under the over-arching theme of Tourism development.

The projects were developed and implemented following successful networking with other Local Action Group partners in Northern Ireland, Ireland, Finland, Estonia and Latvia.

The projects were implemented with the assistance of match funding from Causeway Coast & Glens Council and delivered the following outcomes:

- Development of a new tourist trail throughout the Borough's less visited areas
- Improvements to beach access, facilities and dune protection
- Improved facilities for water based tourism at Camus and Drumaheglis
- Improved landscaping, parking and viewing platforms at Portaneevy viewpoint
- Improvements to the International Appalachian Trail walking route

The projects also led to visitors from partner countries visiting our area and spreading the message of the fantastic tourism offering we have on our doorsteps.
