3.	NORTHERN IRELAND COURT SERVICE – 6 MARCH 2019
	Increase in Court Fees – April 2019

In 2016 the Northern Ireland Courts and Tribunal Service (NICTS) consulted on proposals to increase court fees. Following this, a three year phased increase to court fees was agreed and incorporated into legislation. The first increase of 10% was applied to court fees in April 2017 with the second increase of 7.5% coming into effect on 1 April 2018. The next increase is now due and will come into effect on 1 April 2019, when a further 5% increase will be applied to all court fees, including enforcement fees.
