HARBOUR AND MARINA CHARGE INCREASE 2019/2020

Council's Infrastructure department manages 13 Harbour & Marina facilities throughout the borough. The annual income generated from this service area is circa £260k.

The prices currently charged during the 2018/2019 season are as follows:-

In addition to the fees shown, other charges apply in relation to:

- Shorter berthing periods
- Services provided
- Berthing or harbour use outside the main contract season period.

Note: As per Council decision March 2018, a 45% reduction is applied to all registered and licenced fishing vessels berthing permanently in CCGBC harbours. This reduction does not apply to marina use.

A full schedule of current dues and charges has been included for information. (See appendix A).

Two options are proposed to increase the prices for 2019-2020 season.

- Option 1: Prices are increased at the rate of inflation (CPI) of 2.1%. This will result in additional annual income of £5,460.00 based on current levels of use.
- Option 2: Prices are increased at 5% to achieve rates income proposed on the rates spreadsheet of £13,000.

Recommendation 1.

It is recommended that Council approve Option 2: Prices are increased at 5% to achieve rates income proposed on the rates spreadsheet of £13,000.

Removal of freeze on commercial vessels (charter vessels).

Following the Harbour & Marina charging appraisal report (6th March 2018) Council agreed to option C from the proposals in the report. This option saw the freeze of Harbour and Marina rates at all facilities for commercial vessels (charter vessels). This was to enable further research into the need for such discounts or greater incentives to support these tourism/leisure businesses.

Consultations with Council's Tourism Department have led to the conclusion that there is currently no supporting evidence to provide discount for charter vessels.

Note:

The current freeze facilitated the Ballycastle charter vessels with an 8.6% reduction in standard fees last year. This will now be removed to provide equality throughout the Borough. Charges for charter vessels will revert to standard fees.

Recommendation 2.

It is recommended to remove the current freeze provided to charter vessels and apply standard rates for the 2019/2020 season.

<u>Special consideration for vessels engaged in mariculture seaweed business</u> on Rathlin Island.

As part of the charging appraisal brought to Council 6th March 2018 and following consultation with harbour users, officers removed Rathlin Island charges from any increases to protect the Island economy and give officers time to further explore the needs of the harbour and its users on the Island. In line with such documents as the "Rathlin Island Action Plan" and following consultation with Council's Economic Development Department there is need to support additional business within this Island community and is integral to the future sustainability of the Island economy.

During the consultation last year with all users, officers were asked to apply the discount enjoyed by the fishing vessels to mariculture seaweed business. One such

business is the recently established Mariculture Seaweed Business "Islander Kelp LTD". The Island based business grows seaweed at sea for the food industry and requires the safe berthing of 3 vessels at Rathlin Harbour. These vessels are used to maintain the at sea farm and during the harvesting of its products. This business is unique to the area and experiences further restrictions as it is based on the Island. During the consultation process the business owner requested that Council consider their business as a special case and that the 45% concession offered to the fishing vessels be applied to their vessels.

Council is not bound by Rathlin Island policy, but in terms of economic development and destination management, it would be advantageous to support a unique business like this, as well as grow its economy, in the aspiration that others may follow.

In conclusion:

- Reduced fees would be supportive to a start up and relatively unique business.
- A concession on the standard rate would be supportive to several actions and outcomes under the Ministerial Policy, which are listed above – an increase will not help to maximise employment opportunities in water-based businesses, nor will it deepen the scope of the economy.

This level of financial support equates to approximately £480.00 per annum.

Recommendation 3.

It is recommended to apply the same fee rate on Rathlin Island for mariculture vessels as is applied to fishing vessels.

Legacy cap on Commercial vessel operators in CBC harbours.

Legacy policy in CBC had limited the number of charter and fishing vessels operating in its 3 ports, Portrush, Portstewart and Portballintrae. No evidence or rational existed or exists today to warrant this restriction. Additionally no such restriction are in place in any other of Council's harbour facilities.

Recommendation 4.

It is recommended to remove any legacy restrictions on limiting the number of commercial operations in any of its harbours or marinas.

Inner dock mooring for tenders

No fee will be applied for the allocation of an outhaul mooring in the dock area. As space is limited moorings will be allocated on a first come basis. All tenders should be properly fendered and insured. Size limits may apply.

Outhaul mooring permit for rowing boats

A £50.00 fee will apply to anyone who requests to deposit an outhaul mooring for a rowing boat. Before permission is granted the Harbour Master must approve the type of mooring and its location.

General dues and charges

Cruise Ships

Passenger landing.....£3.00 per manifest passenger

Vessels alongside requiring additional Port Security measures to be set up will be charged on an individual basis. Costs will be given on booking subject to availability.

A late cancellation fee of £100 may apply if notice given less than 48hrs prior to arrival.

Ice

Provision of ice will be charged at £1.00 per 10ltr unit (Portrush Harbour only)

Dry storage

Dry storage will be charged at £150/m2 per year or part thereof. (Where applicable)

Trailer storage

Trailer storage for non-contract vessels will be charged at £20.00 per month. Trailers will be only stored in designated areas.

Access key fobs

Additional or lost access key fobs will be charged at £10.00 per unit.

Quayside storage

There are no charges applicable for quayside storage of items. Only the areas designated storage must be used. All other items will be removed and the costs will be payable by the goods owner.

Restrictions on types and sizes of items will apply. No storage of hazardous goods, oils, chemicals etc. will be permitted. Please contact the Harbour Master for further information.

Bulk items/goods

Bulk goods transported to or from the harbour will be subject to charges of £2.00 per metric tonne.

Storage of any bulk items will be limited and should be agreed with the Harbour Master prior to delivery. Standard harbour berthing dues and charges may apply to vessels involved in the transportation of the items or goods in addition to charges on the goods.

Anchoring within the Harbour Area

Any vessel requiring anchoring within the port limits must contact the Harbour Master prior to doing so to request permission. A charge of £0.25 per GRT may apply.

Waiting list application fee

A £50 refundable fee is applied to all waiting list applications. For further details please contact your local Harbour and marina office.

Concession rates

Rathlin

Annual, summer or season berth/ mooring holders based at one of CCGBC facilities will have free berthing at Rathlin Harbour and Marina for a period of up to 3 consecutive nights stay. This will be subject to availability and may be limited during busy times such as Bank Holidays, regattas, or if space is required for organised cruises. Please contact Rathlin Harbour staff to confirm availability and booking. Tel.07724 594118

All other Council Harbour/Marina facilities

Annual, summer or season berth/mooring CCGBC customers will have 50% discount on berthing at other CCGBC Harbour and Marina facilities for a period of up to 3 consecutive nights stay. This will be subject to availability and may be limited during busy times such as Bank Holidays, regattas, or if space is required for organised cruises. Please contact Harbour/Marina staff to confirm availability. Prior booking is essential.

Concession rates are not available to slipway customers. Normal berthing/mooring rates apply.

Notes

- Vessel lengths will be rounded up to the nearest 0.1 mtr.
- Up to 7 mtr rates will apply to vessels up to and including 7 mtrs. Vessels greater than 7.01 mtrs will be rounded up and be charged at 7mtr and over category rates.
