	<p>DAERA has commenced a stakeholder engagement exercise on Higher Education Tuition Fee Policy at CAFRE.</p> <p>The Department undertook a Review of CAFRE Higher Education Tuition Fees in 2017/18. The review found a disparity in the level of fees charged for different degree programmes at CAFRE, as well as differenced in the amount charged to CAFRE students compared with students studying for degrees at Further Education College's and Universities elsewhere in Northern Ireland. In June a focus group identified a range of potential policy options for future HE Tuition Fee policy at CAFRE.</p>
