## **1.0 Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise members of the outcome of a recent court case taken on behalf of Council by our Animal Welfare service provider.

## **2.0 Background (to include any previous decisions of Council)**

- 2.1 On the 6<sup>th</sup> December 2019 at Coleraine Magistrates court a defendant pleaded guilty to an offence under section 4 of the above Act (causing unnecessary suffering) to a single equine. The defendant at the time owned a number of horses and the remainder were in good health as confirmed by the veterinary inspector employed by Council at that time.
- 2.2 The Judge stated that it was clear that other animals were fine, but that the care received by this single horse was not acceptable and the defendant's failure to act lead the animal to suffer for a period.
- 2.3 The defendant was fined £250, £15 offenders levy fee and £230 costs (£100 legal costs, £21 Court Costs and £109 vet costs) and given 26 weeks to pay.
