	The consultation would affect any users of fluorinated greenhouse gases ("F-gases") in Northern Ireland in the folio sectors of industry: a) refrigeration systems, b) air conditioning (including in motor vehicles), c) heat pump equipment, d) F-gas based solvents, e) high-voltage switchgear, f) insulation foam, g) refrigerated lorries and trailers, h) aerosols, i) fire protection, j) magnesium smelting/casting, k) Organic Rankine Cycles ("ORCs"), and l) chemical manufacturers and suppliers.
