1.0 Background

1.1 BT Payphones consulted the Council on 30th August 2018 on the removal of a public payphone outside the Coast Bar and Restaurant, 144 Seacoast Road, Limavady.

2.0 Detail

- 2.1 BT have advised that the phone box has received no use during the last twelve months and are therefore proposing to permanently cease the service at this location. The telephone box is of the traditional design painted red.
- 2.2 BT has advised that they are meeting their obligation to provide a Universal Service as there are other kiosks in the vicinity. The nearest phone box is located at Linenhall Street Junction, Catherine Street, Limavady.
- 2.3 BT have an obligation to consult with the relevant public bodies on the proposed removal. They require the Council to respond after 42 days and within 90 days giving their comments or any objections received from the local community.
