## The Electoral Office for Northern Ireland – Local Council Polling Scheme Review

Correspondence has been received from the Electoral Office for Northern Ireland to advise that polling stations used at local elections are set by law in the Polling Station Scheme which is reviewed every four years. The next scheduled review will take place later this year.

The draft local Polling Station Scheme will be published in mid-September 2018. Council is asked to help in ensuring that it is brought to the attention of all who wish to comment on it during the consultation period which will run for 12 weeks after the Scheme is published. .Comments received will be published on Electoral Office website.

Those living in the locality or who have particular needs may suggest a building that would be more suitable than the one identified in the draft Scheme. Some local feedback would help to ensure the final version of the Scheme is the best that can be done.
