1.0 Purpose of Report

This report seeks approval to complete the revocation process to the Street Trading resolution affecting Clare Street Ballycastle to assist Councils Leisure Services Department in further animating that area at the 2019 Lammas Fair event.

2.0 Background

Council report Item 9, 190205 set out a revocation process in compliance with the legislative requirements of the Street Trading Act (NI) 2001 to the legacy Moyle District Council Street Trading resolution for Clare Street, Ballycastle.

3.0 Process

In accordance with the legislative requirements of The Street Trading Act (NI) 2001, in the intervening period Officers from the Licensing Section, have undertaken and completed consultations with the public, PSNI, Department for Infrastructure and the three traders who availed of the right to street trade at this location during the 2018 Lammas Fair event.

No formal objections to the proposal were received from any of these parties.

4.0 Recommendation

- 1. Having noted that no representations were received it is recommended that Council revoke the designation resolution for Clare Street, Ballycastle.
- 2. In accordance with the requirements of The Street Trading Act (NI) 2001 it is recommended that this decision is then publically advertised to have effect from 1st August 2019.
