PATH LINKING IRISH GREEN STREET AND BACKBURN PARK, LIMAVADY

Whereas it appears to the **Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Council** that the public path to which this order relates is not needed for public use having regard to the extent to which alternative path via Benevenagh Drive provides access from Irish Green Street to Backburn Park Limavady.

And where **Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Council** has consulted the Department and other appropriate bodies in pursuance of Article 18(1) of the Access to the Countryside (Northern Ireland) Order 1983 (hereinafter called "the Order").

Now therefore **Causeway Coast & Glens Borough Council** in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 14 of the Order and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following order: -

1. The public right-of-way over the land described in the Schedule hereto and shown brown on the map annexed to this order shall be extinguished at the expiration of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. This order may be cited as the **Causeway Coast & Glen Borough Council and Backburn Path** Extinguishment Order 2023.

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

Backburn Path to be extinguished from Irish Green Street (IGR: C 67226 22741) to Backburn Park (IGR: C 67423 22836) between St Mary's Limavady, 72-90, Irish Green Street, Limavady, County Londonderry and Limavady High School, Connell Street, Limavady, County Londonderry.

Alternative path via Benevenagh Drive provides access from Irish Green Street to Backburn Park Limavady.
