Previously, the site of Carnroe Weir was identified as being suitable for hydro-electric power generation and a consultation exercise which included these proposals was undertaken at that time. Although studies showed that this could be achieved without significant environmental impact, it has now been decided that the development of hydro-electric power generation will not be progressed at this site at this stage and as such, this EIA will be solely concerned with the refurbishment of the weir.

As part of the consultation exercise, Council is asked to provide a response on any concerns regarding the proposed refurbishment of Carnroe Weir. Before the Council can respond to this matter, it will require consideration by the Planning Committee. The next available date for such consideration is the meeting scheduled for 27 September 2017.
