	<p>In June 2014, based on a recommendation from the Minister of the Environment, the NI Executive formally agreed that the Local Government Staff Commission would be wound up in March 2017.</p> <p>As a consequence of this decision the existing Code of Procedures on Recruitment and Selection, which is based on the involvement of the Commission throughout the recruitment process, will no longer be applicable.
