	The Department currently operates a two stage process; Stage One is an internal review, which can be followed by a Stage Two review if the applicant remains dissatisfied with the outcome of Stage One. The current Stage Two review includes a hearing by an external panel which make a recommendation to the Head of Paying Agency. This is already a lengthy process which can add to the uncertainty experienced by applicants.
