Background: Translink continue with upgrade work to the line connecting Londonderry and Belfast. Trains stop in at locations throughout the Borough including Ballymoney, Coleraine (connects to University & Portrush), Castlerock and Bellarena. As part of the work the layouts at the level crossings at Castlerock and Bellarena are being upgraded/refurbished

Detail: Work includes provision of new barriers, lights, signs, cattle-cum- trespass guards, audible warning and road markings. The control of the signalling will based in Coleraine. Ultimately, on completion of the line upgrade, the new timetable will show an increase in trains and reduced journey times. This should encourage greater visitor numbers to the Causeway Coast area.
