3.0 LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS)(NI) ORDER 1987

ARTICLE 14 - BYE-LAW FOR THE CONTROL OF THE BUSINESS OF TATTOOING

The above Bye-law requires any person who wishes to carry on the business of tattooing to register themselves and their premises and to observe the Bye-law relating to the cleanliness and hygiene of premises, practitioners and equipment to protect customers against the risk of infection.

On 7 March 2016 Colin Creane made application to the Department to register to carry on the business of tattooing at Colour Tattoo Studio, 40a Catherine Street, Limavady.

The premises has been inspected by an officer from the Department and found to comply with the requirements.
