1.0 Background

The 'Protocol for the Operation of the Planning Committee' sets out the requirement to provide monthly updates on the number of planning applications received and decided.

2.0 Details

- 2.1 Weblink A and B on page 3 provides a list of planning applications received and decided respectively by Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council in the month of May 2016. Please note these exclude Pre-Application Discussions; Certificates of Lawful Development Proposed or Existing; Discharge of Conditions and Non-Material Changes, to correspond with official validated statistics published by DFI.
- 2.2 Table 1 below details the number of planning applications received and decided as well as the number of live planning applications in the system and those in the system over 12months. Please note that these figures are unvalidated statistics extracted from internal management reports.

- 2.3 As can be concluded from the table, performance is consistent in terms of the number of applications received and decisions issued, with decisions issuing continuing to exceed those received, reducing the overall number of live planning applications in the system.
- 2.4 The number of over 12 months applications remains constant and Table 2 below provides a further breakdown of the over 12 month applications in the system. With the 12 month Action plan in place to reduce the over 12month applications in the system, a month by month comparison of figures below will indicate progress.
